### Additional Fees

Students may also be charged the following fees in certain circumstances:

#### **Lost ID Fee: \$10**

After initial Student ID is issued, student may pay fee if the ID is lost.

#### **Courier Fee: \$100**

The Office of Admissions will mail the international student's I-20 packet by courier service upon the student's request, and if the country to be delivered to allows FedEx delivery service.

#### **Parking Fee: \$30**

Assessed to student's account upon purchase of parking permit each year.

#### **Late Registration Fee: \$100/semester**

Assessed to student's account if student does not register for classes in the allotted period of time.

#### **Document/Transcript Fee: \$10**

Assessed to student's account upon request of transcript or official letter from Registrar. First official transcript after completion of program is free.

#### **Commencement Fee: \$20**

Assessed to student's account the semester of the student's graduation ceremony.

### Residence Life Fees 5-month contract

Deposit: \$300 (\$100 non-refundable)

PO Box Rental: \$45 per year (no matter check out date, no refund)

Rent/Month: Marian Hall-\$350 Pan Hall-\$295

Linen Pack: \$50 (optional-includes pillow, cases, towels, sheets, bed cover, mattress pad)

Fridge Rental: \$25 (optional per semester)

TV Rental: \$25 (optional per semester)
