INSTRUCTIONS:

Am I Eligible?:

The Colorado Heights University General Grant & Scholarship application process is open to any degree applicant who meets ALL of the following criteria:

- ◆Admitted to CHU in an undergraduate degree-granting program.
- ◆Enrolled for a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours per semester. If last semester, enrolled, for a minimum of six (6) credit hours.
- ◆Must complete a new application each year, as scholarships are granted per academic year, please remember scholarships are reviewed after semester.
- ◆Demonstrate financial need by addressing work, family and other special circumstances in the personal essay. The student need not have qualified for other financial aid.

How Do I Apply?:

The CHU General Grant & Academic Scholarship application process is simple, but please pay attention to details.

1. Contact the Office of Financial Aid to receive an application.
2. Submit your completed application by one of two ways:
 - ◆In Person: Deliver to Financial Aid Office in Room 202 of Administration Bldg.
 - ◆By Mail: Send application & requested documentation to:

3. Incomplete applications will NOT be accepted.
4. Attach a resume, transcripts and a letter of recommendation

The Selection Process:

Once your completed application has been received by the Financial Aid office, the following will occur:

- ◆All applications will be reviewed by the CHU Scholarship Committee
- ◆All applicants will be notified within one (1) week of the scheduled committee meeting to inform them whether or not they have been chosen to receive a CHU scholarship.

What is the Scholarship Award?:

The CHU General Grant & Academic Scholarship is awarded per academic year, but reviewed after semester. Undergraduate students must maintain a 3.25 GPA and receive no "I" (Incomplete) or "W" (Withdrawal) grades on the previous semester to be considered for a scholarship or maintain scholarship awarded.
